Bible Story: The Road to Emmaus (The Life of Jesus) • Luke 24:13-35

Memory Verse: "I have come so they may have life. I want them to have it in the fullest possible way." John 10:10b, NIV

Bottom Line: Live like Jesus is alive.

Crafts: Exploring Biblical Truths Through Creativity

Create a safe place to connect and learn how the Bible story applies to real life experiences through creative, hands-on activities and discussion questions.

1. Skate!

What You Need: craft sticks, beads, washi tape, scissors, hot glue gun, ultra fine point permanent markers

What You Do:

- Give each kid a craft stick to decorate with supplies.
- Invite kids to personalize their boards with washi tape cut into strips, shapes, or patterns. If they wish, they can add words or designs with the permanent markers.
- When they are done decorating, they need to pick 4 beads, go to a leader, and get the beads hot glued onto their boards.
- Kids do not use the hot glue gun, only the leaders in the room.
- When kids finish, let their boards try and invite them to perform ollies, flips, and other tricks with their boards!

What You Say:

"Jesus said, 'I have come so they may have life. I want them to have it in the fullest possible way.' When Jesus rose from the dead, He made a way for us to have life forever with Him. And life with Jesus is the BEST possible life, because with Jesus we can have hope; with Jesus we can have peace; and with Jesus we can have joy! So remember: **[Bottom Line] live like Jesus is alive!"**
